Follow the steps below in Analyst

- 2 Apply the below filters:
 - a. Select Region
 - b. Sort by occupation
 - c. Sort by # of Postings
 - d. Select Top Occupations
 - e. Review the Job Postings that are highest.

- 4 Review the relevant data points to help you see the bigger picture for employer activity.
 - a. Job Posting data points
 - b. Employers
 - c. Skills
- 5 Jump to the Occupational Overview
- 6 Review Statistical Labor Market information about the desired occupation and see how the job postings connect to the government data we know about this occupation.
- 7 Go to the Company Talent Profile, note employer trends, where certain positions are being hired, and how needs of employers have changed over time.
